### 2015 Training and recruitment

Learn how to safely respond to wildlife emergencies and aid wildlife casualties. While this training is tailored for animal control officers, park rangers and rehabilitators, it is also suitable for the novice.

The classroom portion covers laws and regulations, human safety, capture strategies, animal handling and restraint, and basic wildlife first aid. \$60.00 early registration up to 1 week before.

On the second day (hands-on outdoors) attendees receive instruction on proper set-up and use of equipment. \$40.00 early registration up to one week before.
